Philadelphia, PA (September 4, 2007) – The National Constitution Center is offering exciting new tours for adult groups exclusively in September. Guests can choose from the *Presidential Tour* or the *Historical City Walking Tour* to broaden their National Constitution Center experience and learn more about our nation’s rich history. Reservations are required for each tour and can be made by calling 215.409.6800.

During the *Presidential Tour*, groups will take a 30-minute guided tour of the Center’s main exhibition, *The Story of We the People*, including *Signers’ Hall*. This tour is offered at a special discounted price of \$10 per person for groups of 20 or more.

The *Historical City Walking Tour* will take guests outside the museum walls to learn more about the moments that established our country. After a guided experience in *Signers’ Hall*, visitors will walk through the Historic District to hear stories about Christ Church, Benjamin Franklin’s grave site, and Independence Mall. This tour lasts approximately one hour. Admission costs \$15 per person for groups of 20 or more.

All tours include admission to the Center’s main exhibition and the award-winning multimedia theater presentation, “Freedom Rising”.

The National Constitution Center, located at 525 Arch St. on Philadelphia’s Independence Mall, is an independent, nonpartisan, nonprofit organization dedicated to
